



## Warren Valard Bigelow

Bigelow, Warren Valard passed away peacefully at home on Sunday, March 19, 2017 at the age of 93. He is survived by Muriel, his wife of 74 years, six children: Warren (Kati), Westley, Brent (Diane), Ross, Kyle, and Lisa (Guy Watkins); 18 grandchildren, and 39 great grandchildren. Graduate Roosevelt High School, Mpls, January 1942. Warren was in the 9th United States Army Air Corps., 394th Bomb Group, 584th Squadron pilot and co-pilot on a B-26 Marauder bomber in WW II, stationed in the European Theatre. Post war he worked for Puritan Compressed Gas Co. He soon started his own company, now known as International Medical Inc., which he ran until he was 92 years old. Warren loved to hunt and fish, returning yearly, for over 50 years, to the family homestead in Taber, Alberta, Canada. He enjoyed traveling and took many of his children, and grandchildren on European, African, and Asian trips, visiting many World War II airfields and Normandy invasion sites. He enjoyed reading history books and the New York Times. He enjoyed flying and owned his own plane for many years after the war.
