Wayne August Quehl, born September 29, 1951, passed away peacefully on March 6, 2025, at the age of 73 after a three-year battle with glioblastoma. He is survived by his wife, Barbara; sons: Matthew (Kari), Benjamin (Julia), and Jonathan (Lora); grandchildren: Holden, Addison and Greyson, as well as a soon-to-arrive baby boy due in July. He also leaves behind a twin sister, April Barnes (Craig) and his niece, Rebecca Barnes.

Wayne earned his electrical engineering degree from Valparaiso University, where as a member of Delta Theta Chi, was affectionately known as "Bird." He later earned his marketing MBA from DePaul University in Chicago. Wayne's career included Hewlett-Packard, XO Communications, WorldCom, and numerous other telecommunications companies, where he was known for his sales ability and steady management skills.
