Jopp, Willi A. Age 92 of Robbinsdale, passed away on March 4, 2021. Preceded in death by his parents, Laura and Willi Jopp; and brothers, Erwin Jopp, Gerhard Jopp, and Konrad Jopp. Willi will be deeply missed by his loving wife of 64 years, Lydia; his sons, Kenneth (Deborah) and Richard (Chrissie); grandchildren, Abram (Amanda), Laura, Conrad, and Zoe; and great-grandson, Felix.
