Screeden, William G. "Bill" of Edina, MN, passed away September 9, 2011, at the age of 95. In retirement, Bill was an active member of Kiwanis, and of Our Lady of Grace Catholic Community in Edina. Bill will be remembered for his love of golf; Iowa Hawkeye basketball and football; boating, water skiing and fishing on Lake Minnetonka and on the Whitefish Chain near Brainerd, for playing a good game of bridge with his wife and friends; and as a loving and devoted husband, father and grandfather.
