William Bissonett, age 85, passed away peacefully on April 17, 2026. He was born on September 27, 1940.

Bill is survived by his loving wife, Mary, whom he married in 1984, and his children:

Rob (Mindy), Rick (Amy), and Amie (Larry). He was blessed with four Grandchildren, Anna, Ryan (Hallie), Raegan (Jack) and Ellie and Great Granddaughter, Sloane. He was preceded in death by his first-born son, William Alfred Bissonett, his sister Emily Williams, as well as his parents, Lorraine and William Bissonett.

In 1997, Bill suffered a massive stroke that changed the course of his life. Through the devoted care of Mary, along with his own relentless optimism and deep faith, he went on to live nearly 29 more years—an inspiring testament to his strength and resilience.

Bill and Mary shared a life full of simple joys and meaningful adventures. They loved traveling, fishing, hunting, and, most of all, spending time together. Bill had a lifelong passion for cars and drag racing. He competed on the track until the early 1970s, later sharing his enthusiasm with others as a drag race announcer at Brainerd International Raceway.

Professionally, Bill built a successful career in commercial construction, culminating in his own company, Bissonett Construction Services. He took great pride in helping businesses bring their spaces to life and was known for

his dedication and strong work ethic. Bill often joked that he only worked half days-meaning 12 hours a day.

Bill will be remembered for his perseverance, sense of humor, and the deep love he had for his family. His legacy lives on in the lives he touched and the memories he created with those closest to him.
