Rowe, William Henry Jr. "Bill" age 96, of Mpls, passed away Sun, Nov 3. Preceded in death by wife, Sarah; parents, William H. He served in WWII 1943-46, first with the MPs in the US theater and then as a medic in the India- Burma theater, stationed in Calcutta. He met his wife Sarah in India. After the war ended and they married in Mpls, Bill worked at First National Bank (now US Bank) in the Trust Dept for 43 years. He was a 77 yr member of Gethsemane Episcopal Church, an original founder of the Twin Cities Civil War Roundtable and a tireless volunteer for many organizations. Bill loved baseball, opera, travel, history, dogs, railroads, walking the skyways, a good martini and spending time with friends. He was a lifelong fire buff, living for a time at a Fire Station, and an avid reader with an encyclopedic knowledge of history.
