Zachary Jason Myers, fondly known as "Zach", passed away on Saturday, August 24, 2024 in Baton Rouge, Louisiana at the too-young age of 26. He was born in Columbus, IN but moved to Minnetonka, MN when he was six years old. He currently resided in Baton Rouge, LA. He leaves behind to cherish his memory his parents Lorraine & Martin Myers, his brother Nathan Myers and sister-in-law Amanda, uncles and aunts Derek and Soo Wait, and Geoffrey and Ellen Wait, numerous family members and many, many friends. and most recently had been employed at Pearce Group in Prairieville, LA, as their foundry metallurgist. He relished technical challenges and was a gifted problem-solver. Zach loved the hands-on nature of his work there and gleefully worked alongside the production teams. He enjoyed teaching others the science that fascinated him, and appreciated learning from his co-workers. He was thought of as a kind and caring manager and co-worker, and was known widely for his compassion towards others.

Zach's final earthly gift was to be an organ donor. Today, there are several people whose lives are better because he made that gift.

Above all else, Zach treasured family and friends. He was a devoted and loving son, brother, nephew and grandson, and fiercely loyal to his friends. Although Zach's time here with us was brief he leaves a legacy of love and memories that will be cherished forever.

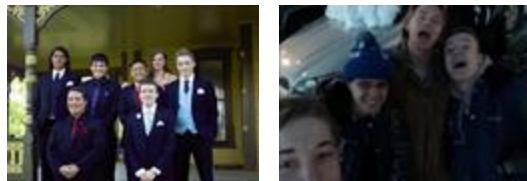
