Sajka, Zinaida (Kapcewicz) Age 100 of St. Anthony, longtime resident of NE Mpls passed away November 17, 2011. Zina was born April 21, 1911 in Haraburdawsczyna, Belarus to Sciapan and Alena Kapcewicz. Preceded in death by her husband, The Rev. Taras Sajka in 1973; her parents, 3 sisters, 2 brothers, grandson, David Sajka; and by her beloved sponsors, Edward and Frances Nelson of Hinckley, MN.
